The Backcountry Trust was formed in 2017 to support the maintenance of publicly accessible, non commercial, backcountry huts, tracks and mountain bike trails in the natural environments of Aotearoa/New Zealand.

Our country has an enviable network of these facilities in our wild places that cater for a diverse range of recreation, as well as supporting the important biodiversity work being carried out by volunteers, the Department of Conservation, and complimentary organisations. Bequests have long played an important part to assist with maintaining and in some cases enhancing this network of facilities.

The Backcountry Trust now contributes to much of the combined workload to maintain this network and we do this in association with many volunteer groups around the country. Bequests help ensure our survival and every dollar we get through bequests goes directly into conservation of this network of backcountry facilities for future generations.

We intend to be around for the long haul to ensure a sustainable approach to this conservation work and over the past few years we have successfully completed maintenance on more than 280 huts in the network and maintained over 1,500 kilometers of track. We have also become an owner of huts that are run for the public good on public conservation land and Mataketake Hut in South Westland is a fine example of how a bequest can leave a lasting legacy for the outdoor community to enjoy for many generations.
